Methodology

Data Collection

This study was conducted via touch-tone response automated phone survey conducted 4-6 April 2022. Surveys are conducted between 17:30 - 20:20 weekdays and 10:00 - 17:30 Saturdays at the local time of respondents so as to not over-sample nonworkers and stay-at-homes.

The study was conducted among a sample of n=915 people aged 18 years and over from a population of 76,532. Telephone numbers were licensed from a commercial provider and include both landline and mobile phone numbers. In this survey 45.9% of respondents were reached via mobile phone.

Weighting

Following the completion of the surveys, the data was cell-weighted by gender and age to reflect local population proportions.


The effective sample size following weighting is 539 meaning the effective margin of error is +/-4.2%.






How certain are you that you will vote that way on election day?


Being undecided, to which of the following do you have even a slight leaning?










